# Overview

In 1965 Taylor & Francis launched Wykeham Publications and began book publishing. In 1988 it acquired Hemisphere Publishing and the company was renamed Taylor & Francis Group to reflect the growing number of imprints. In 1990 Taylor & Francis exited from the printing business to concentrate on publishing. In 1998 Taylor & Francis Group went public on the London Stock Exchange and in the same year the group purchased its academic publishing rival Routledge for £90 million.<sup>[10]</sup> Acquisitions of other publishers has remained a core part of the group's business strategy.<sup>[10]</sup> Taylor & Francis merged with Informa in 2004 to create a new company called T&F Informa, since renamed back to *Informa*.<sup>[10]</sup> Following the merger, T&F closed the historic Routledge books office in New Fetter Lane, London and relocated to its current headquarters in Milton Park, Oxfordshire.<sup>[11]</sup> Taylor & Francis Group is now the academic publishing arm of Informa and accounted for 30.2% of Group Revenue and 38.1% of Adjusted Profit in 2017.<sup>[12]</sup>

Taylor & Francis publishes more than 2,700 journals, and approximately 7,000 new books each year, with a backlist of over 140,000 titles available in print and digital formats.<sup>[12]</sup> It uses the Routledge imprint for its publishing in humanities, social sciences, behavioural sciences, law and education and the CRC Press imprint for its publishing in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.<sup>[5][13]</sup> In 2017, T&F sold assets from its Garland Science imprint to W. W. Norton & Company and then ceased to use that brand.<sup>[14][12]</sup>

Although generally considered the smallest of the 'Big Four' STEM publishers (Reed-Elsevier, Wiley-Blackwell, Springer, and Taylor & Francis),<sup>[15]</sup> its Routledge imprint is claimed to be the largest global academic publisher within humanities and social sciences.<sup>[16][17]</sup> The company's journals have been delivered through the Taylor & Francis Online website since June 2011. Prior to that they were provided through the Informaworld website.<sup>[18]</sup> Taylor & Francis ebooks are now available via the TaylorFrancis website.<sup>[19]</sup> Taylor & Francis operates a number of Web services for its digital content including Routledge Handbooks Online,<sup>[20]</sup> the Routledge Performance Archive,<sup>[21]</sup> Secret Intelligence Files<sup>[22]</sup> and Routledge Encyclopedia of Modernism.<sup>[23]</sup> Taylor & Francis offers Open Access publishing options in both its books<sup>[24]</sup> and journals<sup>[25]</sup> divisions and through its Cogent Open Access journals imprint.<sup>[12]</sup> Taylor & Francis is a member of several professional publishing bodies including the Open Access Scholarly Publishers Association,<sup>[26]</sup> the International Association of Scientific, Technical, and Medical Publishers,<sup>[27]</sup> the Association of Learned & Professional Society Publishers<sup>[28]</sup> and The Publishers Association.<sup>[29]</sup> In 2017, after collaborating together for several years, T&F purchased specialist digital resources company Colwiz.<sup>[30][31]</sup>

The group has approximately 1,800 employees<sup>[6]</sup> located in at least 18 offices worldwide. Its head office is based in Milton Park, Abingdon in the United Kingdom, with other offices in Stockholm, Leiden, New York, Boca Raton, Philadelphia, Kentucky, Singapore, Kuala Lumpur, Hong Kong, Beijing, Shanghai, Taipei, Melbourne, Sydney, Cape Town, Tokyo and New Delhi.<sup>[6][32]</sup>

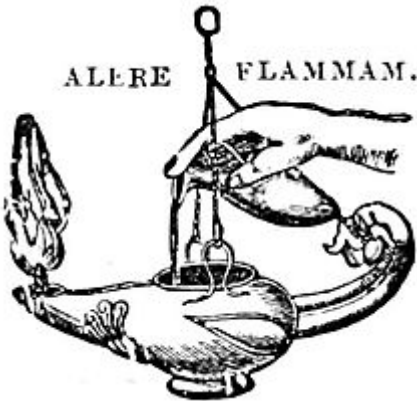

## Controversies

In 2013, the entire board of the *Journal of Library Administration* resigned in a dispute over author licensing agreements.<sup>[33]</sup>

In 2013-2016, the toxicology journal owned by Taylor & Francis, *Critical Reviews in Toxicology*, published Monsanto-sponsored ghostwritten articles: Williams et al.(2016),Greim et al.(2015) and Kier & Kirkland (2013). *Critical Reviews in Toxicology* was accused of being a "broker of junk science" by the Center for Public Integrity. <sup>[34]</sup> According to Waldman

et al., Taylor & Francis was already conducting an investigation into Monsanto's misconduct with respect to the ghostwritten publications in *Critical Reviews in Toxicology* in 2017. Editor Roger McClellan is quoted: "These are serious accusations relative to scientific publishing canons and deserve very careful investigation.... I can assure you that Taylor & Francis, as the publisher, and I, as the Scientific Editor of *Critical Reviews in Toxicology*, will carefully investigate the matter and take appropriate action."<sup>[35]</sup> As of 2018, no action has been taken by Taylor & Francis.

In 2017, Taylor & Francis was strongly criticized for getting rid of a public health journal editor-in-chief who accepted articles critical of corporate interests. The company replaced the editor with a corporate consultant without consulting the editorial board.<sup>[36]</sup>

Taylor & Francis created what has been called "predatory journals" in a scheme to transfer rejected manuscripts from its other journals to the Cogent Series. Authors of rejected manuscripts are asked to submit their papers to a Cogent Series journal for a significant pay-to-publish transaction. The scheme, however, was exposed as having a sham peer review process when Cogent Social Sciences accepted a hoax article, "The conceptual penis as a social construct." When the authors announced the hoax, Taylor & Francis retracted the article.<sup>[37]</sup>
